Ans. (a) Different between Web page and Website

Web page	Website
A webpage is defined as a component of a website that includes contents like text, media, etc. It also comprises links to many other relevant webpages.	A website is a cluster of different webpages of different topics addressed to certain URLs.
It is a single document that is displayed by the web browser using a specific URL address.	It is a collection of many documents. Web browsers are used to access such documents using specific URL addresses attached to the website.

(b) The web browser is an application software to explore www (World Wide Web). It provides an interface between the server and the client and requests to the server for web documents and services. It works as a compiler to render HTML code used to design a webpage.

Two commonly used web browsers are Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox.

Outline is a line that is drawn around elements (outside the borders) to make the element "stand out"	Border properties allow you to specify the style and colour of an element's border
We can't specify if individual sides should have an outline or not.	Borders for individual sides can be styled and a border-radius can also be specified.

This includes the dissemination of data, and quick and effective communication.

- (i) All Governmental information can be uploaded onto the internet. Citizens' access specifically access whichever information they want, whenever they want it, at their convenience.
- (ii) Transparency directly links to accountability. Once the functions of the government are available, we can hold them accountable for their actions.
